### **WELCOME TO THE 2010 SKATE BY THE LAKE**

Thank you for entering the 2010 Skate By The Lake Figure Skating Competition to be held April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010, at the Manchester Ice and Events Centre in McCall, Idaho.

Enclosed is the tentative practice and competition schedule. Practice Sessions and Competitive Events will take place on Saturday April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 (7:00am – 5:00pm). Please review the tentative schedule carefully and double-check with the official schedule at the rink each day of the competition.

Skaters have been placed into events according to their age and test level. The schedule below lists the number of skaters in each event. In any event with only one entry, the skater will be given the option of skating an exhibition or critique if time permits, skating the event and being scored and placed (1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup>) relative to the rulebook for that event, or withdrawing from the event (without a refund). If a critique is desired, please complete a critique request form when checking in at registration.

### **AWARDS**

Awards will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> places in each group. Awards will be presented in the mezzanine of the Manchester Ice and Events Centre located on the zamboni end of the ice arena. Skaters should wear competition outfits and skates. There will be an official photographer available. Skaters will be able to make their own arrangements with the photographer. Taking photos with personal cameras is also an option.

### **MUSIC**

Please provide program music on **CD's only (no CDRW's or Cassettes)**. They **must** be turned in at the registration desk at the time of registration, and will not be returned until the event has been skated. These should be competition CD's, not practice media, and must contain only one cut of music. CD's shall be plainly marked with the competitor's name, his/her professional's name, the event and music duration. The Music Committee will accept no responsibility for breakage or damage, but will take every precaution in their handling. It is highly recommended that skaters have an extra competition CD on hand as a backup. Music may be played during practice ice and skaters should come prepared with **practice media**.

### **TICKETS**

Admission will be free for all spectators, however, limited to the rink seating capacity.

### **OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD**

An Official Announcement Bulletin Board will be available at the Registration Desk. All scheduling will be posted on the official bulletin board; such posting supersedes all other scheduling. Results will be posted on the glass at the lobby end of the rink. The starting time of each event will be posted and this will be considered sufficient notification to the competitors. Competitors must report to the monitor and be ready to skate **45 minutes prior to the posted starting time for their events**. Sanctions from US Figure Skating and US Figure Skating Basic Skills are posted on the official bulletin board.
